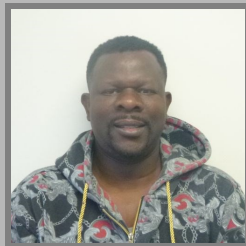

SAFETY TALK

Slips and falls are the most common accident that occur in the workplace. It is important that our staff do everything possible to ensure that we have posted wet floor signs in all necessary areas to try and deter slips and falls.

It is required that a wet floor sign be placed at every entrance into an area where we are mopping a floor. If it is a restroom, one wet floor sign at the entrance is acceptable as long as it stays there until the floor is completely dry. If it is a lobby area, multiple wet floor signs may be necessary to cover all entrances to the area. If it is a cafeteria, enough signs must be posted so that anyone entering the area as well as anyone who is already in the area can visibly see a wet floor sign. Please follow best practices for your site when placing wet floor signs; if you have questions—speak to your manager!

It is required that wet floor signs stay posted until the floor is completely dry. Do not just put the wet floor sign away when you are moving on to another area if the floor is still wet.
